"In addition to the reduction and elimination of hazardous substances, CardLogix recycles plastic cards, paper and gold as an integral part of our company process". The European Union has mandated that all suppliers follow the RoHS directive completely no later than July 1, 2006. RoHS 2002/95/EC became law in February 2003. It restricts the use of lead, cadmium, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyl (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE) flame retardants.
