Although the meters still accept coins, the card is a faster, more convenient and safer method of payment.

Ken Indorf, VP of Sales for CardLogix, says that Santa Monica is one of many cities throughout the U.S. turning to smart card-based parking meters. According to the Smart Card Alliance (SCA) the \$17 billion parking industry currently has 30 programs for smart card meters throughout the U.S.
